








# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



# 1. Introduction

Keeping in view quality education through an Ideal Boarding System in line with Code of Conduct and Character Building Strategies of Pakistan Army, Scheme of Cadet College Ghotki was sponsored by Ministry of Education Government of Pakistan. The foundation stone was laid by the Honorable Chief Minister of Sindh (Late) Ali Muhammad Khan Mahar on 03 March in 2005. The College started functioning on Nov, 28, 2010 with initial intake of 114 Cadets. Up to now, eight consecutive batches of cadets have successfully passed out. At present, the college, with its five Boarding Houses and relevant facilities of high standard, can house 400 plus cadets from class VII to XII. Furthermore, committed with its Vision, Mission and Scope, the college has been developing in all aspects with the financial patronage of the Government Sindh and dedicated efforts of the staff rendered under the supervision and guidance of the Board of Governors of Cadet College

# 2. Mission

Grooming through quality education with modern facilities and focusing on physical and psychological nurturing of the cadets by models of discipline and character building of Pakistan Army in sync with universally recognized Ghotki. human values, is the mission of Cadet College Ghotki.

# 3. Scope

The college provides quality education from class VII to XII in Science Subjects (Pre-Medical and Pre-Engineering only) as per Syllabi and scheme of studies of Sindh Text Book Board Jamshoro. However, in Class VII & VIII The College is affiliated with the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Sukkur, Sindh. Furthermore, comprehensive provision of physical

training, psychological care and personality grooming of cadets done as patterns of Pakistan Army and Ideals of boarding life enable them to make their way easily to civil and military services of the country as well as other reputable fields of their choice around the world.





## 4. LOCATION

Cadet College Ghotki is a residential institution established on an area of 253 Acers. It is located 12kms away from Ghotki City on Pakistan National Highway N-5, leading to district of Rahimyar Khan, Punjab. Sukkur and Rahimyar Khan Airports, Railway, M-5 Motor Way and N-5 highway makes it the most easily accessible Cadet College throughout the country.







#### 5. GOVERNING BODY

The college is governed by the Board of Governors constituted by the Government of Sindh. The Board is headed by the General Officer Commanding 16 Division Pano Aqil, with sufficient representation from Government and Civil Society.



#### 6. ADMISSION POLICY

Admissions to college are made in class VII and VIII in accordance with the eligibility criteria given below.



#### 7. ELIGIBILITY

- Sons of persons domiciled in Sindh are entitled to apply for admission against seats reserved for residents of each Administrative Division i.e. Sukkur, Larkana, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad, Karachi and Nawabshah (Shaheed Benazirabad)
- b) Sons of persons domiciled in provinces other than Sindh.
- c) Sons of serving or retired defense personnel.



#### A. AGE AND QUALIFICATION

- i) Candidates seeking admission in class VII must have passed class VI.
- ii) They must not be under 11 and over 13 years of age on the closing date of admission.
- iii) Candidates seeking admission in class VIII must have passed VII. They must not be under 12 & over 14 years of age on the closing date of admission.
- iv) No relaxation in age is permissible.





#### **B. WRITTEN TEST**

- Candidates have to appear in the subject of English, Mathematics, Sindhi / Urdu and General Knowledge (Intelligent Quotient + PakistanStudies+General Science).
- Written test is conducted at following centers, provided, a minimally required number of ii. candidates applied is obtained i.e minimum 20x candidates.
- 1) Karachi 2) Larkana 3) Bhawalpur
- 4) Multan 5) Lahore
- 6) Rawalpindi

7) Quetta



#### C. MAIN CENTRE

In any case, Cadet College Ghotki remains Main Centre for Written, Interview and Medical examinations.

- Standard of test for admission to class VII and VIII are of classes VI and VII respectively according to syllabi of Sindh Textbook Board, Jamshoro.
- Result of test is uploaded on college website as early as possible after written examination.
- Success or failure of the candidates in written test is communicated to them.
- Whereas, the detailed results of the test are confidential so queries are not entertained in this regard.
- In case, a required number of candidates do not come up to the minimum standard for the purpose of admission from the quota of particular division such seats are filled from the quota where more deserving candidates are available.

NOTE: College admits no liability for delay / non-delivery/ loss, etc of written /interview& Medical call / test letter due to the postal system fault / Failure.



#### D. MEDICAL TEST AND INTERVIEW

Candidates who qualify written test are interviewed and medically examined according to the prescribed medical standard. The decision of College Medical Board on Medical fitness / unfitness of candidates is irrevocable.

#### A. Procedure of Submission of Fee

- i. Fee can be submitted in all branches of ALLIED BANK LTD: Pakistan, through a printed challan provided by college.
- ii. No other mode of payment is acceptable.
- iii. The parents may either pay fee for the whole year (full fee is charged for vacation period also) at a time or in two equal instalments.
- iv. All charges will be increased up to 10% per annum after approval of competent authorities.
- v. Fee may be raised during the year depending upon prices of food items, services and utilities.

#### **B.** Late payment of Fee

A fine of Rs. 200 per day will be charged in case is fee without pay with in the 15 days of issue of challan. To further discourage the frequency of late payment cases the following penalties will also be imposed against defaulters.

- i. Suspension from college till deposit of outstanding fee.
- ii. Striking the cadet names of college rolls and withholding of documents / testimonial (Original as well as photocopies) till recovery of all outstanding dues.
- iii. With holding of Application / Admission process to other colleges / universities / BISE exams.

Note In extraordinary circumstances fee may be paid in quarterly instalment by parents after application of a written request by College authorities.

# 11. Scholarships

College provide 50% tuition fee concession to students who secure position in Board Exams. Moreover high performing students in need of financial help are given 100% tuition fee concession as per college policy and decision of Chairman Board of Governors.

## 12. Migration

Cadets admitted to the college have to stay and study here till they promote to the final Stage i.e H.Sc Part -II exams. Therefore, those requesting for migration / school leaving certificate before completion of their F.Sc, shall have to pay an amount as mentioned below:

- (I) After completion of year: Rs. 5000.
- (ii) After Passing S.S.C Pa II (Matric): Rs. 10,000.

#### 13. Academic Sessions

There is one academic session in a year adjusted in accordance with policy of the College Education and Literacy Department Govt. of Sindh. The College calendar containing all details of activities for the whole year is sent to the parents / guardians at the beginning of the session.

#### 14. Curriculum and Examination

Curriculum for classes IX to XII is based on syllabi prescribed by the Sindh Text Book Board, Jamshoro, Sindh. Whereas, the curriculum for Classes VII and VIII is based on Oxford course / STBBJamshoro syllabus. Internal examinations, i.e Fortnightly, First Term, Monthly, Mid-term, Pre-Board and Annual Examination are held as per academic calendar to assess the progress of cadets in studies.

## 15. Assessment / Evaluation

The process of academic evaluation and personality assessment carried out round the year, through terminal tests / annual examinations, various activities and exercises organized in the college. A comprehensive dossier of cadet's annual performance is maintained by the admission branch and House Masters respectively.

#### 16. WITHDRAWAL / RELEGATION / RUSTICATION

A Cadet can be withdrawn / relegated / rusticated from the college owing to his low performance markers in studies set as below:

- (i) Class VII: If the cadet is unable to get 45% marks in the Annual Examination.
- (ii) Class VIII: If the cadet is unable to get 45% marks in the Annual Examination.
- (iii) Class IX: Cadet's failure even in one subject may result in his withdrawal.
- (iv) The promotion to class XI is not an automatic process. It depends upon cadet's excellent performance in in his previous class.
- (v) After the declaration of the result of the SSC Pa -II (Class X) annual examination, a cadet is not allowed to continue in class XI, if he fails to secure at lest 55% marks in each science subject.
- (vi) Cadet involved in discipline and moral turpitude cases are withdrawn irrespective of their academic session or performance.

#### 17. SCIENCE LABS

For an effective teaching of science, all practical are carried out in well-equipped physics, chemistry and biology laboratories.









### 18. COMPUTER TRAINING

Keeping in view the importance of computer science and information technology in our daily life, the cadets are put into practice of laying hand on the keyboards of computer right from the first day of their entry in the college. There is an air conditioned and well equipped IT Lab / supervised by qualified teachers and an instructors.





#### 19. LIBRARY

The college has a well-equipped and tastefully laid-out library to cater for intellectual and mental growth of cadets and teachers. The library catalogues contain books on various subjects of natural and social sciences, humanities and arts including universally acclaimed reference works. Moreover, weekly, monthly, quarterly magazines and daily newspapers (English, Urdu, Sindhi) are available. For each class there are two compulsory library period in a week as well.







#### 20. DISCIPLINE



Adjutant of the College, who is often of Captain/Major Rank, is responsible for the overall discipline of cadets. He also administers Military, physical and sports training of the cadets through his drill staff and appointment holders. Moreover, there is a college Discipline Committee comprised of Adjutant and two Senior Faculty members, which inspects, supervises and suggests means and measures for further improvement of Discipline of the cadets.

#### 21. CADETS' APPOINTMENTS

On the basis of academic results, discipline, disposition, performance in curriculum and extra curriculum activities and personality each year following appointments are made from class XII (senior most cadets):

- a) College Captain
- b) Deputy College Captain
- c) House Sargent Majord) College Sports Sergeant

e) House Captain









### 22. BOARDING HOUSE

At present, there are ve (5) houses in the college. These are known with their different Titles and Mottos. Each house accommodates around 75 cadets. A house master and deputy house master manages each house as per college rules and regulations. This team is responsible to prepare the cadetsfor inter house competition in all the dimensions.

#### **Evaporating Cooling System (ECS)**

To provide a comfortable environment to Cadets, the College is in the process of installing ECS in all houses Mathelo and Iqbal House are equipped with ECS currently.



#### 23. CADETS' MESS

The Mess functions under the supervision of Adjutant and mess Manager. Cadets are also associated with the management of the mess. The mess committee meets regularly to draw up the menu, discuss ways and means of improving the messing standard.

The adjutant acts as student mess in charge and is assisted by the mess manager. To ensure mess quality recommend menu changes the mess committee meets regularly. A high protein and seasonal vegetable based menu is designed to cater to the needs of growing cadets.







#### 24. MEDICAL FACILITIES

There is a well-equipped dispensary supervised by a qualified Doctor. Records pertaining to the health of cadets are maintained regularly. The college has its own ambulance to rush cadets in the case of emergency to the DHQ Hospital / C.M.H Pano Aqil. Moreover, the College Medical Committee frequently inspects and advises for further necessary improvement of Medicare of cadets.







### 25. PRAYERS AND NAZRA



Five times prayers and Nazra-e-Quran are compulsory in college routine, in addition various activities are carried out for religious and ideological orientation of cadets.







### 26. CAFETERIA

A Spacious and fully furnished cafeteria has been built in college to facilitate cadets, their parents and employees of the college.









#### **27. SHOPPING CENTER**

To facilitate cadets and employees for their smooth stay in the college a shopping center has been constructed, which includes a Barber shop, Cobbler shop, Tailor Shop, Fruit shop & General Store.







#### 28. LAUNDRY SHOP

A well-equipped laundry shop is established to provide the cadets and employees with facility of ironing, washing and dry cleaning their clothes.







#### 29. RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

The Cadets have been provided with T.V, Indoor games and gear in the hostel to utilize their leisure hours, there is also a Recreation Club which arranges movies on weekends, excursion trips, variety of programs, dramas and many activities relevant of recreation of cadets.

#### 32. PARENTS' VISIT TO COLLEGE

The cadets joining this institution do, naturally, take some time to adopt themselves to the new atmosphere of the college. The shorter the visits of the parents the better the boys adjust themselves to the new environment. It is therefore, in the interest of cadets as well as of the College that the parents restrict their visits to the college to the minimum level unless it is unavoidable. However Parents / guardians can visit their sons / wards only on Sunday declared as parents day from 9.00am to 5.00pm. Cadets are not allowed to invite their relatives / guest.

#### 33. PARENTS – TEACHER MEETING

To keep the parents informed of about their sons academic progress and to discuss their achievements / deficiencies. Teachers-parent meetings are convened regularly. This forum is also utilized to have suggestions of the parents on the over-all betterment of the institution

### 34. LONG WEEKEND / TERM BREAK / VACATION / HOLIDAY / LEAVE

There is a fixed number of holidays and term-breaks as indicated in college calendar. Besides after every forty days a long weekend is scheduled for cadets.

#### 35. DRESS CODE

Cadets are required to wear the following dress on different occasion:

Uniform: Khaki uniform has to be worm during classes, parade and drill.

Walking-out Dress: Walking-out dress as prescribed for the respective seasons is to be put on by all cadets. The

same is to be used during preps, dinner, while going outside the College campus and on leave.

Games and P.T Dress: Shorts, vests and P.T shoes have to be used during games and P.T timings.

Prayer Dress: Shirts / Kurta / Shalwar / Pyjama and cap with black shoe or Peshawari Chappal can be used

for all prayers, including Juma Prayers. During winter, jersey pull-over or sweater is used.
